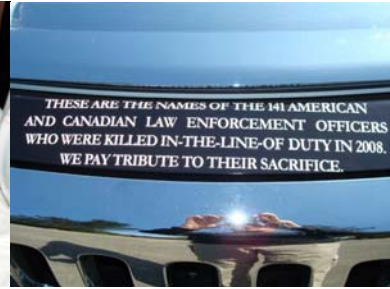

## “Drive To Remember” Dallas Stop-May 7<sup>th</sup> @ 8:00 a.m.



The “Drive to Remember” is a tour from Vancouver, BC south to Los Angeles, CA, then east to Washington, D.C, that raises awareness about officers killed-in-the-line-of-duty. Sgt Steve Gibson, a Canadian Police Officer, will drive a Hummer H3 more than 5,000 miles in 12 Days attending many events including the National Peace Officers Memorial Service. The Hummer H3 is wrapped in striking law enforcement memorial graphics with the names of the American and Canadian officers killed-in-the-line-of-duty in 2008, in the last year alone, prominently displayed on the hood.

The Drive To Remember Hummer H3 will be stopping in Dallas on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at 8:00 a.m. in front of Jack Evans Headquarters. The Lozada Family will be in attendance to sign next to Sr. Cpl. Lozada’s name. Although Sr. Cpl. Norm Smith’s name will not be displayed on the Hummer this year, a memorial will be placed on it in his honor. Sr. Cpl. Smith’s name will be displayed next year.
