ARREST MADE IN MOTHERS DAY MURDER

On September 14, 2009 at 1:40pm, United States Marshals arrested Cesar Dan Hernandez-Sandoval for the murder of his mother on May 10, 2009. This arrest was made possible by the joint efforts of the Dallas Police Department's Homicide Unit, the U.S. Marshals Dallas-Ft. Worth Fugitive Apprehension Strike Team (DFW FAST), U.S. Marshals from the Las Vegas area and the Las Vegas Metro Police Department. He was arrested without incident. Dallas Police Homicide detectives are currently in Las Vegas interviewing Hernandez-Sandoval. His extradition is pending.

Mother Found Murdered On Mother's Day – Son Is Suspect

Dallas Police Homicide Detectives are seeking the public's assistance in locating a suspect wanted for the Murder of his mother. On May 8, 2009, the family of Mrs. Esther Hernandez filed a want to locate report on her because she had not been seen for several days. This was documented on service #130859-W. On Mother's Day, May 10, 2009, Mrs. Hernandez was found deceased inside her residence after her husband began to smell a foul odor. This murder was documented on service number 133023-W

There is an active murder warrant for Cesar Dan Hernandez-Sandoval, the son of Mrs. Hernandez. It appears he killed his mother by homicidal violence and then attempted to conceal her body in the house. When the husband found the body, the son fled the location and has not been seen since. It is believed he is driving a black 2007 Honda Civic with Texas license #933XJS. He has family in Mexico so he may be heading for the boarder.
